## AFFIDAVIT FOR WARRANT OF ARREST AND DETENTION

The undersigned Affiant, who after being duly sworn by me, on oath, makes the following statement:

I have good reason to believe and do believe that:

## Jaime Apodaca H/M 9/30/1994

On or about the 25th day of December, 2018, in the incorporated limits of the City of Austin.

County of Travis, Texas, did then and there commit the offense of:

## Tampering with Evidence – Felony 3rd Degree

On December 25, 2018 at approximately 2243, your Affiant was on duty as an Austin Police Officer wearing the uniform of my position with shoulder patches and badge on my chest. I was also driving a clearly marked Austin Police Department patrol unit equipped with emergency lights and the word "Police" on the vehicle.

On the above date and time I responded to a shots fired call at 2723 S Congress Ave. Multiple reports were received that numerous gun shots had been heard within the complex. Upon checking the area, 5 shell casings were found on the northeast corner of the above address, which is also the building number. The shell casings were all .38 Special per the stamped markings on the casings. Information was later received that the residents of unit #2316 were involved in the shooting.

While on scene, a Hispanic female was seen entering and then exiting unit #2316. When the female, later identified as Melanie, exited the apartment I made contact with her. When asked what was going on tonight, she stated that she fired a gun and ditched the gun. We asked for permission to enter the apartment to ensure no one else was inside. She consented and the apartment was cleared, no one else was inside. Upon being questioned by other officers, Melanie stated the firearm used was a .38 Special revolver and confirmed that she was in an argument with her boyfriend but refused to provide his name. Recent involvement from December 14, 2018 showed Jaime to be her boyfriend.

I was able to speak with residents in a nearby apartment, #2313, who stated they had heard a male and female arguing upstairs earlier. The female was very upset. Shortly thereafter, the residents heard the gun shots. 3 initial gunshots, then 5-6 additional. The 5-6 shots were heard where the shell casings were found, as the resident pointed to the north east corner of the building.

Officers asked Melanie for consent to search her apartment and vehicle to look for the weapon which she agreed to. After signing the consent to search form, I went to effect the search of her vehicle. The vehicle was parked in front of the apartment building and stairway leading up to Melanie's apartment. While searching the vehicle, I found in the floorboard of the driver's seat of Melanie's vehicle a nylon holster meant for carrying a handgun.

Upon completing the search of the vehicle, finding only the holster but no weapon, I turned around to walk back towards apartment 2316. As I turned around and looked up to the second floor landing where apartment 2316 was, I observed a male, later identified as Jaime, in a red shirt and dark pants walk out of the apartment. Because the apartment had already been cleared and the door left open, it's reasonably believed that Jaime entered the apartment while officers were on scene.

He quickly moved down the staircase away from where officers were and turned to go southbound along the west side of the building. I informed other officers on scene of what I saw as the subject had just left the apartment which was part of an active investigation involving a firearm and current information led us to believe another male suspect was involved. I moved south along the same building in an attempt to intercept Jaime. I then saw Jaime running up a staircase in the same building towards apartment 2308. I too ran up a

staircase directly across from the one Jaime was ascending. The two staircases faced each other so that Jaime could see me coming up and I could see him. I loudly yelled for Jaime to "Stop!" so that I could detain and question him about the incident and why he was in the apartment we were investigating. Jaime did not stop, but rather continued to quickly move towards apartment #2308. Jaime appeared to be crouched down in an attempt to avoid detection, opened the door to apartment #2308, and quickly entered it shutting the door behind him.

Officer's then formed a perimeter around the apartment. A nearby male said his step-brother lived in that apartment. I asked the man to call his step-brother and tell Jaime to come out of the apartment with his hands up. Shortly thereafter, Jaime did come out of the apartment. I began giving him commands to keep his hands up and to lift his shirt up by his collar. Instead of complying, Jaime reached for his waistband where weapons are frequently kept. I deployed my Taser which incapacitated Jaime and we were able to detain him.

Upon speaking with Jaime he also confirmed that he and his girlfriend where in an argument earlier, affirmatively linking him to the ongoing investigation. Though he denied discharging a firearm. As we were still on scene talking with Jaime, the primary resident approached an officer to provide additional information. According to the primary resident and his step-brother, both fully identified in the police report, when Jaime entered the residence after failing to stop when I told him to, he entered the bathroom. Inside the bathroom there was a large black plastic trash bag belonging to the primary resident. Jaime created a small hole in the top of the bag and placed a handgun in the bag.

We asked the primary resident for consent to search the apartment to look for the handgun, which he provided. Upon entering the residence and bathroom, we observed a large black plastic trash bag. At the top of the bag where it had been tied, there was a hole where the plastic had been stretched to insert an item. Feeling the bag from the outside, a hard metal object was felt the approximate side and shape of a revolver. Once the bag was opened, inside a black Taurus .38 Special Revolver SN: LM48300 was found. This was the same type and caliber weapon Melanie said she discharged inside the complex.

Jaime was placed under arrest for Evading Detention on foot. After being searched incidental to arrest, a debit card belonging to Melanie was found in his back left pocket affirmatively linking him to Melanie.

Because a male and female were heard arguing just prior to the gunshots, Melanie and Jaime both admitted to arguing, Melanie stated she fired the weapon, a heavy police presence was in the immediate area including the door to Melanie's apartment conducting an ongoing investigation, and credible information was provided that Jaime was attempting to conceal the same type weapon described by Melanie as having been discharged, the totality of the circumstances showed Jaime intended to conceal the weapon with intent to impair its availability as evidence in the investigation. For this reason he was also arrested for Tampering with Evidence.
